

## **ANDREW S. QUINN, ESQ.**

Andrew Quinn, who is one of three founders of Compliance Concepts, Inc., served as an Assistant United States Attorney for the U.S. Department of Justice for seven years. In that capacity, he represented the United States as a federal prosecutor in various civil and criminal healthcare matters. Andrew has been a member of various federal healthcare related task forces and working groups and has been recognized by the United States Attorney General, the FBI, IRS, DEA and the HHS Inspector General for his work in the area of healthcare fraud. He is nationally recognized for his coordination of the DRG 72-hour window project, which encompassed 4,700 hospitals nationwide. Andrew has made numerous speaking appearances throughout the country on such topics as white-collar crime, healthcare fraud, the Federal False Claims Act, HIPAA and pending healthcare reform legislation. Prior to joining the Justice Department, he served an honors clerkship with the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit, was general counsel for a private insurance corporation and was a judicial law clerk to Chief Federal Judge Richard P. Conaboy, the immediate past Chairman of the U.S. Sentencing Guidelines Commission. Most recently, Andrew was appointed to the White-Collar Crime Subcommittee of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Commission on Crime and Delinquency.

In his role at CCI, Andrew is responsible for the coordination of all client compliance engagements and provides board, management, physician and staff training services. In addition to assisting with the provision of litigation support services to an array of providers facing allegations of business-related misconduct, he also represents various healthcare clients in the development of structured settlement agreements and the direct negotiation of settlement terms with OIG and DOJ officials. Andrew participates in the assessment of client compliance levels and the development, implementation and ongoing monitoring of corporate compliance programs.
