

## **K. Bryan Rainey**

Bryan Rainey, who is Vice President of Information Technologies in the Charlotte office of Compliance Concepts, Inc. (CCI), has over 16 years of experience in programming and database development. Bryan began his career with Pinkerton Services Group, where he developed an application for a 24 hour-a-day call center used to gather compliance related information, from approximately 3.5 million employees across multiple companies, in accordance with Federal Sentencing Guidelines for business conduct.

Immediately prior to joining CCI, Bryan was employed as a consultant with Compuware Corporation in Charlotte, NC, assigned to Bank of America where he managed the version control and integrity of all programming code migrated to 900 call center computers located in Tampa, Richmond and Atlanta. In an effort to streamline the migration process, Bryan oversaw the development of an application that was used by the migration team to track and migrate all code sent to the three call centers. Other prior experiences include the development of an application used by First Union Corporation to track and report \$32 million in bonus payouts to relationship managers.

In his role at CCI, Bryan is responsible for managing all development and technical staff resources for Compliance Concepts, Inc. He also serves as lead developer for all software products offered by CCI including the software utilized by CCI's ComplianceLine, a 24 hour-a-day call center. Bryan is very adept at designing and developing software applications, database warehouses and Internet applications.
